Neuro Problems

- Concentration/memory loss
- Dysautonomia
- Headaches



Dry Eyes

- Decreased tear production
- Eyes feel extremely dry
- Itch
- Burn
- Excessive blinking
- Blurred vision
- Light sensitivity



Sinus Symptoms

- Dry sinuses
- Nose bleeds
- Recurring sinus infection
- Chronic sinusitis



Dry Mouth*

- Severe dental decay
- Mouth sores
- Difficulty chewing
- Difficult swallowing
- Oral infections




Lung Issues
